Pete and his wife, Meg, moved to York in 1977 when he accepted a position with the Susquehanna Pfaltzgraff Co. After serving as the Company's VP Finance/CFO for 15 years, he was named President/CEO of Susquehanna's Radio, Cable, and Internet Operations in 1995. Pete retired in 2005 and

formed Hammer Creek Enterprises, LLC, a private investment company, where he remains Principal.

Pete's involvement with Martin Library began in 1996 when he was named Board President, a role he held until 1999. He served on the York County Libraries Board from 2015 through 2021.
