#### CIVIC AND SOCIAL LITERACY

After tragedy strikes, we witness at first the incredible response of individuals and then how affected communities build resilience. Twenty-three years ago, a man walked into a York County elementary school and started attacking people with a machete. The principal was severely injured as she sought to protect her staff and students. This year, that principal, Norina Bentzel, published a memoir describing her experience and how she navigated through the harrowing loss towards lifelong healing. On Wednesday, October 23rd, 6-7:30 pm at the library, you have the opportunity to hear from the author herself. Together with the Rotary Club of Eastern York County, we are honored to bring you an evening in conversation with Norina Bentzel.

Trees offer shade, habitat and a source of food for both animals and humans. As such they are one of the most valuable assets in our community, one that we often take for granted. 
Join the festivities. Read a book about trees to the Library Tales for Tails dogs!
