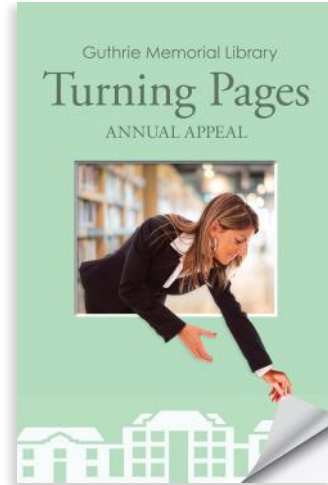

Black History Month

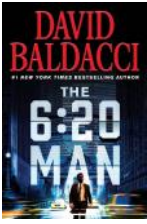

Maintaining cultural activities, such as music, is one example of cultural resistance. During the presentation we will listen to examples of music and look at the lives of musicians during this time. 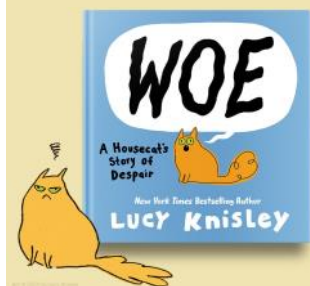

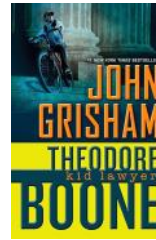
