

So start going through those closets! And remember to say **50018** when dropping off your donations at your nearest Community Aid!

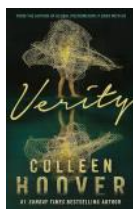
